Where is Beach Week?

When is the final payment due?

- Final payments are due Wednesday, June 8.
- You may make the final payment in person or online at www.fbcwf.org/beachweek.
- · In person our church can take check or credit card

When are we leaving and coming back?

- Check-in will be **Sunday night June 12th, at 7:00p** in the Downtown campus atrium.
- We will be leaving at 8:00p from the Downtown campus atrium.
- We will be arriving **Friday June 17**, at approximately at 11:30p back at the Downtown campus atrium.

What are the rooms like?

- Boys and Girls will be staying in different rooms throughout retreat center.
- Boys will generally be in the bunk houses that sleep between 20-30
- Girls will be in suites that sleep between 8-10
- We will pair each student with the one person they named on their registration form

Who is on my rec team?

· Students will be divided into teams by the FBCWF Student Ministry Staff.

What is cell phone policy?

- Students may use their cell phone on the way to camp and on the way back home. **This is** on the buses only.
- Once we arrive to camp, all student phones will be collected by the FBCWF Student Ministry Staff, powered off, marked with the student name and secured.

PACKING

What to bring & What not to bring

WHAT TO BRING

- REUSABLE WATER BOTTLE (this will be very helpful to take to all of your activities and refill throughout the day)
- Bible and pen
- · SUNSCREEN! and bug spray
- Sunglasses (white sand is very bright) and flip flops
- · Sleeping bag or single bed bedding and pillow.
- TOWELS! Make sure you have plenty of towels as towels are not provided. (We highly encourage that you have separate towels for showers and beach swimming towels)
- Casual clothing for 5 days and free time attire for 4 days
- Swimsuits (For girls: one-piece or a tankini that covers the midriff)
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Tennis shoes (that can get dirty and for service) and sandals/water shoes.
- Spending money for 2 fast-food meals during travel and any souvenirs and snacks. (Students will be responsible for their own money)
- Medications (must be checked in with a camp nurse at registration).
- · Camp T-shirt (wear on the last day).

FOR LATE NIGHT

- Be sure to pack plenty of clothes for your team colors. Team colors will be announced prior to camp, **Wednesday Night**, **May 25** and on social media.
- · Color War Night: team colors
- Hillbilly Prom: bring your glow sticks, western wear
- Luau Night: bring your Luau gear

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Short shorts (i.e. no shorter than a 3.5 inch inseam).
- No halter tops, tube tops, crop top, spaghetti straps, bikinis, or speedos.
- · Clothes with questionable or inappropriate slogans.
- · Any illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products, including vapes, or any vaping products.
- A weapon or dangerous item of any kind, including but not limited to a gun, knife, or fireworks.
- · Water balloons, orbeez guns of any kind
- Electronics are allowed ONLY on the bus ride to and from camp.
 - Any electronics that is not a cellphone (laptops, iPads, tablets, game consoles, etc.) * First Baptist Church is not responsible for any lost or stolen items that were not turned into any FBCWF Student Ministry Staff (such as laptops, iPads, tablets, game consoles, Apple Watches, AirPods, etc.).

CAMP & BUS RULES

**All rules are to be followed at all times, failure to do so can result in being sent home

Campers will be sent home at the FBCWF staff discretion for the following:

- Bringing and/or using illegal drugs, alcohol products, tobacco products (including vapes
 of any kind), or weapons (including but not limited to a gun, knife, or fireworks).
- Proof of stealing personal possessions or items belonging to the camp.
- Being in the room of the opposite sex.
- Leaving the retreat center without adult supervision.
- Fighting at retreat center or on the bus.
- Putting any campers in danger due to the lack of following rules and maintaining a safe camp experience.
- 2. No P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) with anyone.
- All activities are required for you to participate in unless excused by a camp sponsor or camp nurse.
- 4. No pranking of any kind will be permitted while at camp.
- 5. No cell phones will be allowed while at camp, but will be permitted on the bus ride to and from camp.
- **6.** Swimsuits and swim trunks are to be worn only in the swimming areas. *You must* wear a cover up to and from swimming areas.
- 7. All rules specific to Laguna Beach Christian Camp will be strictly enforced.
- 8. All medicine will be given to and administered by the camp nurse.
- You must respect and obey all adult leaders including your small group leader and Laguna Beach Christian Camp Staff.
- 10. During free-time, students are allowed to cross street for basketball or concession only if accompanied by a friend or an adult.
- *The parent/guardian will be contacted by Steven or Jerry for behavior worthy of being sent home.
- *Campers will be sent home at campers/guardian expense for behavior worthy of being sent home.

On the Bus:

- · Respect and obey all adult leaders and bus driver.
- No P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) with anyone.
- You are responsible for keeping the bus clean.
- At any stop you may not get off until HS pastor has explained the plan.
- You are responsible for any items you bring on the bus.

Follow all previously stated camp rules.
