



## "Quenching Thirst"

John 4:4-26 (NIV)

Jesus calls us to be outwardly focused by meeting 4 types of needs:

1. People's Emotional Need for \_\_\_\_\_.

"... It was about noon." *John 4:6b*

2. People's Physical Need for \_\_\_\_\_.

"When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?" (His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.) *John 4:7-8*

"The Samaritan woman said to him, 'You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?'" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.) *John 4:9*

3. People's Spiritual Need for \_\_\_\_\_.

"The woman said, 'I know that Messiah" (called Christ)" is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us.'" *John 4:25*

"Then Jesus declared, "I, the one speaking to you—I am he." *John 4:26*

4. People's Psychological Need for \_\_\_\_\_.

"Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?" They came out of the town and made their way toward him. . ." *John 4:28-30*

"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. ... I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest." *John 4:34-35*
