FAQ

Where is Creek Week?

- Creek Week will be at Minnetonka Christian Camp in Clayton, OK. (1000 Minnetonka Rd, Clayton, OK 74536, (918) 569-7856)

When is the final payment due?

- **Final payments are due Wednesday, May 25.**
- **You may make the final payment in person or online at www.fbcwf.org/creekweek.**

When are we leaving and coming back?

- Check-in will be Monday morning May 30, at 8:00a in the Downtown campus atrium.
- We will be leaving at 9:00a from the Downtown campus atrium.
- We will be arriving Friday June 3, at approximately at 2:30p back at the Downtown campus atrium.

What are the rooms like?

- Boys and Girls will be staying in different cabins.
- Each cabin will have 20-30 students in bunkbeds.
- Each cabin will have 2-3 adult leaders staying with our students.
- We will pair each student with the one person they named on their registration form

Who is on my rec team?

- Students will be divided into teams by the FBCWF Student Ministry Staff.

What is cell phone policy?

- Students may use their cell phone on the way to camp and on the way back home. **This is on the buses only.**
- Once we arrive to camp, all student phones will be collected by the FBCWF Student Ministry Staff, powered off, marked with the student name and secured.

PACKING

What to bring & What not to bring

WHAT TO BRING

- REUSABLE WATER BOTTLE (this will be very helpful to take to all of your activities and refill throughout the day)
- Bible and pen
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Sleeping bag or single bed bedding and pillow.
- TOWELS! Make sure you have plenty of towels as towels are not provided. (*I would highly encourage that you have separate towels for showers and creek swimming towels*)
- Casual clothing for 5 days
- Free time attire for 4 days
- Swimsuits (For girls: one piece or a tankini that covers the midriff)
- Toiletries (Toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, sunscreen, *deodorant*, etc.)
- Tennis shoes (that can get dirty and for service) and sandals/water shoes
- Spending money for 2 fast food meals during travel and any souvenirs and snacks
(Students will be responsible for their own money)
- Medications **(must be checked in with a camp nurse at registration)**
- Camp T-shirt (wear on last day)

FOR LATE NIGHT

- Be sure to pack plenty of clothes for your team colors. Team colors will be announced prior to camp, Wednesday Night, May 25 and on social media.
- Neon Night: bring your glow sticks, and any neon clothes.
- USA Night: pack your red, white, and blue.
- Luau Night: bring your Luau gear

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Short shorts (i.e. no shorter than a 5 inch inseam).
- No halter tops, tube tops, crop top, spaghetti straps, bikinis, or speedos.
- Clothes with questionable or inappropriate slogans.
- Any illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products, including vapes, or any vaping products.
- A weapon or dangerous item of any kind, including but not limited to a gun, knife, or fireworks.
- Waterballons, orbeez guns
- Electronics are allowed **ONLY** on the bus ride to and from camp.
- Any electronics that is not a cellphone (laptops, iPads, tablets, game consoles, etc.)

Camp & Bus RULES

All rules are to be followed at all times,
failure to do so can result in being sent home

1. Campers will be sent home at the parent/guardians expense for the following:

- Bringing and/or using illegal drugs, alcohol products, tobacco products (including vapes of any kind), or weapons (including but not limited to a gun, knife, or fireworks).
- Proof of stealing personal possessions or items belonging to the camp.
- Being in the room of the opposite sex.
- Leaving the campgrounds without adult supervision.
- Fighting on campgrounds or on the bus.
- Putting any campers in danger due to the lack of following rules and maintaining a safe camp experience.

2. No P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) with anyone.

3. All activities are required for you to participate in unless excused by a camp sponsor or camp nurse.

4. No pranking of any kind will be permitted while at camp.

5. No cell phones will be allowed while at camp, but will be permitted on the bus ride to and from camp.

6. Swimsuits and swim trunks are to be worn only in the swimming areas. *Please wear a cover up to and from swimming areas.*

7. All rules specific to Minnetonka Christian Camp will be strictly enforced.

8. All medicine will be given to and administered by the camp nurse.

9. You must respect and obey all adult leaders including your small group leader and Minnetonka Christian Camp Staff.

*The parent/guardian will be contacted by Alex or Jerry for behavior worthy of being sent home.

*Campers will be sent home at campers/guardian expense for behavior worthy of being sent home.

On the Bus:

- Respect and obey all adult leaders and bus driver.
- No P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) with anyone.
- You are responsible for keeping the bus clean.
- At any stop you may not get off until Alex has explained the plan.
- You are responsible for any items you bring on the bus.
- Follow all previously stated camp rules.
